Reports

You child should have come home from with their School Report today. You will notice that your child's end of year report appears different in several ways this year. There are two main reasons for this; firstly, we did not issue a detailed mid-year report in March and secondly, we are following county advice not to use attainment judgements because they are inappropriate in a year interrupted by lockdown.

So, you will find that the reports have a detailed personal comment as you would normally see and details about English and Maths, which would normally feature in the mid-year report. The tick boxes are a measure of how your child has engaged in that subject, not academic achievement.
