For children who learn an instrument at school, I will be in contact with your peripatetic teachers, who will help organise the piece you will perform. Children who are taught in small groups (e.g. violin, guitar, flutes) will most likely perform in these similar groups for the concert.

If you learn an instrument outside of school, please liaise with your music teacher to decide on the best piece to perform, and let me know the title and composer of the piece. Sadly, I am not able to accompany children but can play a backing track if need be, just let me know in advance!

Although we do hope to include all instrumentalists, in the unlikely event of a large uptake, places will be offered on a first-come-first-served basis.

On the evening of the concert, instrumentalists who need to tune instruments will be asked to arrive at 5:40pm, and any other performers at 5:50pm, in time for a 6pm start. Further information will be sent out nearer the concert.

Singing Club will also be performing at the concert – please make a note of the date and a separate sign up letter will be sent out with further details soon (we have already started practising!).
