Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our topic this term, we will be taking the children to Washbrooks Family Farm on Friday 12th June 2026.

The children will need to be in school by **8.45am** as we will be leaving at 9.15am. We will be travelling by coach and will aim to be back at school by 3.15pm (traffic permitting).

The children will need to bring a packed lunch and an extra drink and snack to have once we arrive. Fizzy drinks or sweets are not allowed and please ensure that nut products (including Pesto) are NOT included in your child's packed lunch. If you are unable to provide a packed lunch for your child, one can be provided under the Universal Free School Meals programme (i.e. a sandwich, piece of fruit, biscuit and a small drink).

To order a packed lunch, please book via ParentPay and select 'Chartwells Trip Lunch FREE SCHOOL MEALS ONLY' by Thursday 28th May. Packed lunches cannot be ordered after this date.

Comfortable own clothes can be worn with a school jumper and sensible walking shoes.

Please log in to ParentPay to give consent for your child to take part, and to make payment of **£17.70** per child. The cost is a voluntary contribution but we do need to point out that the visit cannot take place unless all Parents/carers who are able, are willing to contribute. Unfortunately, if we do not receive sufficient monies to cover the cost then we will have to cancel the trip. If you are going to have difficulty in paying then please contact Mrs Maurice, via the school office, to discuss the matter confidentially.

We need to receive your consent and payment by **Friday 5th June**. If we do not receive permission, your child will be unable to attend.
