Accommodation



The Bedrooms:

With 38 bedrooms, Hindleap is able to sleep 164 young people across five accommodation zones.

Our comfortable bedrooms are dormitory style, sleeping up to 6 in a room. The beds are bunkbed style, with bed linen provided.

Accessibility is incredibly important to us, so we have a number of profile beds, night rails, hoists and slings that can be assembled with prior notice.

Visiting leaders are expected to share a room with other leaders but many of our leaders rooms have 'Jack and Jill' style bathrooms.

The Bathrooms:

Each accommodation zone have their own toilets and showers located within it. Whilst many of them are cubicle style, we also have zones that have wet-rooms for those who require them.

Within these wet-rooms, we have a number of different shower/commode chairs, toileting chairs and hoists.

The Classrooms:

We have a number of rooms at Hindleap that can be used during your stay.

These rooms can be used for a number of reasons, if you are interested in doing some teaching on your stay, we have tables and chairs or the room can be transformed for a film or activity night. We have a DVD player, projector and TV to be used.

Just let our staff know if you're interested in adding this to your programme.

The Dining Room:

The dining room is our largest room in the main building, filled with tables for all the young people on the residential overlooking the beautiful grounds and Ashdown forest.

The perfect place to relax with some warm food and a good view!



The Playground:

Not used enough energy in your activities throughout the day? No worries! Our playground is the perfect place to use the last bit of energy you have left.

Our playground is perfect for young people to play basketball, football and netball alongside any other games. Floodlit at night, you'll be able to play throughout the evening.

It also doubles as the deer hangout spot at night, keep an eye out for them!

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A typical day

7:45 - 8:30

Breakfast! The most important meal of the day to prepare for a day of action packed fun.

8:45 - 12:00

Your first two activities of the day. They each last an hour and a half so don't forget your drink!

12:15 - 13:15

Woohoo! Lunch! Time to rest and refuel with some wonderful food and view from our dining hall.

13:30 - 16:45

Its time for some more activities. Good job you fueled up at lunch!

17:15 - 18:20

Dinner time! Its been a busy day so you'll be ready to eat. What dessert will you go for?

19:00 - 21:00

The day isn't quite over! Campfires and night walks with our instructors or movie nights with your leaders await.

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What to bring?

Residential Kit-List

Essential clothing:

- Underwear and socks
- Pyjamas
- Clothing suitable for the weather
- Layers of old, warm clothing
- Waterproof coat and trousers
- Indoor and outdoor shoes
- Sun or winter hat

Essential items:

- A packed lunch (for your first day - AM arrival)
- Water bottle
- A towel
- Toiletries (no aerosols)
- Bin liner for wet or muddy clothes

Optional extras:

- A small torch
- A book or travel games
- Electronics are at the decision of the leaders of the group

Top tip: Make sure you have clearly labelled everything!

Don't bring anything you wouldn't want to be lost or damaged

A full kit list will be shared.
NO electrical devices, smart watches, mobile phones, cameras etc.

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Food

A well deserved, warming dinner will hit the spot after a fun filled day of activities. We offer a selection of different meals throughout the day, with a hot meal at every mealtime, alongside side dishes, salad bars and fruit.

We ask that all groups, that are arriving in the morning, bring a packed lunch for their first lunch. We recommend packing this meal in disposable packaging (a paper bag or sandwich bags) to save Tupperware coming home at the end of the trip.



Dietary requirements:

Our catering team are able to cater to all dietary requirements, providing we are informed well in advance of the trip.

Whether it be foods your child can't eat or won't eat, we will have food that they are able to eat whilst they are with us. All dietary requirements need to be communicated with our programming team via the groups medical forms.

We can provide alternatives for allergy and intolerance sufferers, cultural diets and food phobias.

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Safety

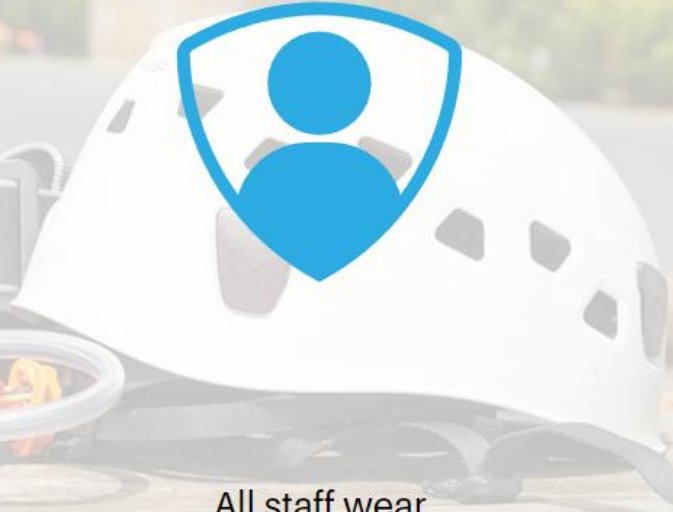


Each accommodation block can only be accessed via fob key.

All staff are DBS checked and Instructors are first aid trained.
