

'100 Club' - The Rules

- There will be a monthly draw from January 2015 through to August 2015.
- St Peter's Primary School 100 Club is a source of funding for the school and operated by the PTA.
- It is a game of chance that will result in financial gain for St Peter's Primary School PTA fundraising and will result in financial gain for one lucky number holder each month.
- 50% of the monthly income raised shall be returned in the form of cash prizes.
- 50% of the monthly income raised will accrue to PTA fundraising.
- Participants must be 18 years of age and a current member of St Peter's PTA ie a parent, guardian or a staff member of the school.
- There are 100 membership numbers available.
- You can purchase multiple membership numbers.
- Each participating member shall be allocated an individual membership number, one for every £10 spent, and is non-refundable.
- Each individual membership number gives you one entry into each monthly draw.
- The value of each monthly entry is £1 except for January and July when the value is £2 each.
- Total prize money is £500 and £500 will be raised for St Peter's School PTA fundraising, assuming all one hundred numbers are sold.

- The winner of the monthly draw will receive £50 except for the months of January and July where the entry value is doubled to £2 and the prize money for those months will doubled to £100, assuming all one hundred membership numbers are sold.
- If the membership total is less than 100 then the prize money and PTA fundraising will be smaller but will remain at 50% each of the total membership revenue raised for each month.
- Applications and payment of £10 for each membership number must be received by the 100 Club organiser by the end of the school day on Thursday 29th January 2015 to be eligible to participate in the 100 Club.
- A winning number will be drawn at school on the final Friday of each month, or the next school day if it's a holiday; the first draw will be on Friday 30th January 2015.
- Winners will be announced in the school newsletter, on the school's website and face-book page.
- Winners will be notified via phone or e-mail and arrangements made to receive the prize-money.
- Please inform the 100 club organiser if any of your contact details change.
- Information given on the application form will be kept in a paper file and will not be entered onto a database.
- These rules may be subject to change at times and such amendments will be posted on the school website.
