SMART.

S stands for **SAFE!**



Never give out your personal information to people you are chatting to online.

M stands for **MEETING!**



It is dangerous to meet up with people that you have only known online without a responsible adult being present.

A stands for ACCEPTING!



Accepting emails , videos and opening files from people you don't know can be dangerous.

R stands for RELIABLE!



Information you find on the internet may not always be true.

T stands for **TELL!**



You should always tell a responsible adult who you trust if you have any worries or concerns online.

Here are a few examples.

BE SMART ON THE INTERNET

Safe

You must not tell anyone your personal information. Don't send any messages to strangers.

Meeting

You need to be safe on the internet. There is Rule 27 on the internet.

Acepting

Don't accept inappropriate messages or pictures on the internet because they might be rude or you might be too young.

Reliable

You will not get in trouble if you ask your parents; you should not get upset if you understand.

Tell

do not accept inappropriate messages or pictures on the internet.
