

Consultation on Admission Arrangements for School Entry 2017/18

Requirements of the Consultation on Admission Arrangements

Admission Authorities must set (determine) admission arrangements annually. Where changes are proposed to admission arrangements, the admission authority must first publicly consult on those arrangements (except where the change is an increase to a school's published admission number, or is made to comply with mandatory requirements of the School Admissions Code). If no changes are made to admission arrangements they must be consulted on at least every 7 years.

Consultation must be for a minimum of 6 weeks and must take place between 01 October and 31 January of the year before those arrangements are to apply, to allow parents, other schools, religious authorities and the local community to raise any concerns about proposed admission arrangements.

St Peter's Church of England (Aided) Primary School has changed the admissions arrangements in accordance with the School Admissions Code 2014, published by the DFE. The consultation period on admissions arrangements for St Peter's Church of England (Aided) Primary School, Henfield, will be open from 17th December 2015 and close on 29th January 2016.

We are inviting comments on St Peter's Church of England (Aided) Primary School, Henfield admission arrangements during the consultation period.
